ONLIFE project 18 months later...

Since Covid-19 emerged to a pandemic in 2020 many governments around Europe have taken extreme measures of lock down. Teachers had to teach from home suddenly for the first time, students required to continue learning from home for the first time and parents had to support their children becoming in some ways a home teacher. This new reality found most teachers, unprepared to adapt their teaching, creating, learning and living habits and be as productive and effective while staying at home.

In order to help address this, the ONLIFE Erasmus+ project aims at empowering teachers and school leaders to face the digital transformation of the educational system in time of crisis.

Based on the implementation of the second output, the consortium has developed an online learning environment for teachers in school education, to update emerging digital competences for online and blended learning. 
